Showers and fog forecast

A day after the highest temperature of the year so far was recorded — 33.7°C in Chiayi — there could be brief showers in northern Taiwan today, the Central Weather Bureau said yesterday. From tomorrow through Thursday temperatures are expected to drop as the weather turns unstable as a front lingers over the nation, the bureau said. Brief showers are forecast in regions north of Taichung, in the east and mountainous areas of the south, it said, adding that there could be heavy rain on Monday and Tuesday. Fog is expected to be a feature of the weather pattern over the next week, with visibility in western Taiwan and islands to the west of Taiwan likely to be affected by fog or low cloud, the bureau said.
