Inversions for emphasis

Inside his room sits a motionless monkey. BUT

The turtles he fought in a curious fashion.

Life he saw as a ceaseless and courageous contest.

Gone are the potted plants.

Prepositions as verbs

"I shall no more to sea."—Shakespeare

Right down the road to their station wagon, where the lights were on.

Back to his plan.

Conjunction adverbs

Miss Brodie, however, had already fastened on Mary who was nearest to her.

Participles, adverbs, and pure adjectives at the end

The lamp had been standing cobwebbed in a corner, unplugged.

From mind the impetus came and through mind my course was set, and therefore nothing on earth could really surprise me, utterly.

It will remain with me, imperishable.
